

Tear Trough and Temple Masterclass

Aim:

To provide an overview on the use of HA dermal fillers on tear trough and temples for cosmetic uses.

Objectives:

Name the layers of the epidermis and describe the therapeutic effects of dermal filler, including their limitations when used as a cosmetic treatment.

Define the mode of action of dermal filler, explaining their therapeutic effects including limitations of use and any concerns with toxicology.

Select patients suitable for tear trough and temple dermal filler, identifying contra-indications, cautions, side effects and possible adverse reactions.

State any pre-treatment care and recognise the need for consent.

Identify the need for topical or local anaesthesia and demonstrate its safe administration.

Demonstrate the safe use of dermal filler in treating the mid face, (tear trough and temples), including the correct equipment, using an ultrasound, dose and injection techniques.

Summarise with appropriate written and verbal aftercare advice to patients who have received dermal filler.

Demonstrate the appropriate use of clinical record taking and recall good practice in relation to handling complaints.

Describe safe storage and disposal methods for products and equipment used.

Explain the insurance requirements to practice these treatments.
