

Advanced Lip Masterclass

Aim:

To provide an overview on the use of HA Lip Dermal Fillers for cosmetic uses.

Objectives:

Name the layers of the epidermis and describe the therapeutic effects of Dermal Filler, including their limitations when used as a cosmetic treatment.

Select patients suitable for Lip Dermal Filler, identifying contra-indications and cautions, side effects and possible adverse reactions.

State any pre-treatment care and recognise the need for consent.

Identify the need for topical or local anaesthesia and demonstrate its safe administration, including how to deliver local anaesthetic for lips.

Demonstrate the safe use of Dermal Filler in shaping lips, including the correct equipment, dose, use of ultrasound and injection techniques using a needle and cannula.

Summarise with appropriate written and verbal aftercare advice to patients who have received Dermal Fillers.

Demonstrate the appropriate use of clinical record taking and recall good practice in relation to handling complaints.

Describe safe storage and disposal methods for products and equipment used.

Explain the insurance requirements to practice these treatments.
